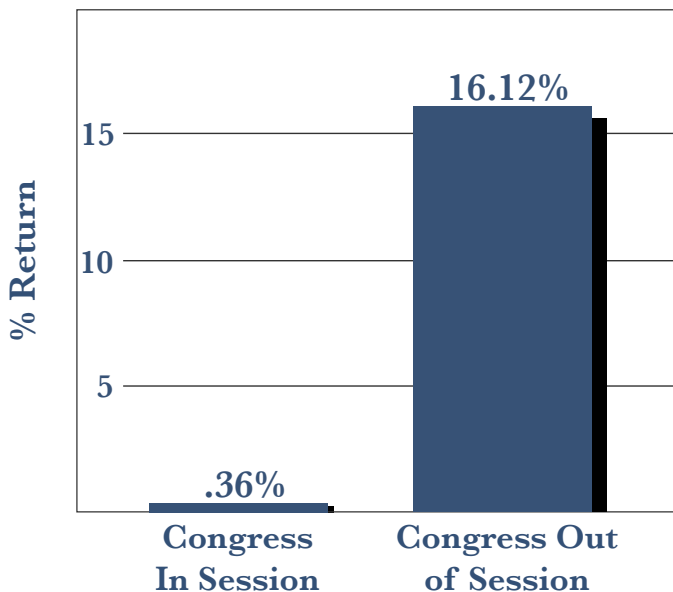


S&P 500 Index

In calculating these price gains, the Advisor used the performance of the S&P 500 without including dividends due to difficulties in obtaining daily data. If dividends had been included, the performance numbers for both in and out of session days would have been higher.
